Who?

They connect artists with local youth through **project learning as teaching artists, art directors, and mentors.**





What?

They will be guiding students with completing the following **school-wide projects** in **phases**:

1. John Dewey HS Podcast Channel/Station
2. Songwriting, Music Production, & Music Videos (RHYME Program)
3. Large School-Wide Mural Project

When?

Every **Monday & Wednesday** during the school year, the organizations will be working on **phases** of projects with students during **lunch periods 4-7**.

The **podcasting phase** is first, and begins **October 16th**, running **until winter break**.

The **demo/launch** for podcasting will be in the **cafeteria periods 4-7** on **Tuesday, October 10th**.



Where?

Students will be able to work with the organizations in the library's **Makerspace** and **Audio Lab**.

Students and **clubs** interested in using the spaces **outside of periods 4-7** can book either of these rooms **after school** or during other **free periods**.
